- If you were born on or before December 18, 1971, you must also upload your
 - **Certificate of Indian Blood (CIB)** must be issued from the **Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA)**
 - Or
 - Tribal Enrollment Verification Letter or Tribal ID Card (if you are unable to obtain your Certificate of Indian Blood due to adoption or other unforeseen reasons)

DESCENDANTS
Individuals are eligible for Class D stock (also known as descendant stock) if they meet all of the following requirements:

- Were born after December 18, 1971
- Are 18 years of age or older
- Are lineal descendants of an original Sealaska shareholder (meaning a direct descendant such as a child or grandchild, etc.)
- Are United States citizens
- Are not shareholders of another ANCSA Regional Corporation (except by gifting or inheritance)

LEFT-OUTS
Individuals are eligible for Class L stock (also known as Left-outs stock) if they meet the following requirements:


- Were born on or before December 18, 1971, and are still living
- Were eligible to enroll in Sealaska Corporation in 1971 (pursuant to ANCSA) but were not so enrolled
- Are "Native" as defined by ANCSA
- Are at least 1/4 Alaska Native
- Are not currently enrolled in Sealaska Corporation, or any other ANCSA Regional Corporation (except by gifting or inheritance), or the Metlakatla Indian Community



Are you the lineal descendant of an original Sealaska shareholder?

Lineal descendant is defined as being a descendant through your parent, grandparent, great-grandparent and other great. You cannot name a sister or brother, aunt or uncle, great aunt or great uncle, or other "collateral" relation as your direct lineal ancestor.

The direct lineal ancestor I am identifying who was an original Sealaska shareholder is my:

You must provide a piece of identifying information for the person identified above. You can use either their date of birth or the last four digits of their Social Security Number.

Sealaska's privacy policy does not permit releasing information of a shareholder record, except to the living shareholder of record. You will need to get the identifying information for a living relative directly from that relative. If the ancestor you identified is deceased, Sealaska may be able to provide their identifying information.

Notes:

If the person named as the original Sealaska shareholder is your parent, you must upload your certified birth certificate that lists your name and your parents name, sufficient to establish the direct lineage between you and the parent who is the original Sealaska shareholder.

If the person named as an original Sealaska shareholder is a grandparent, great grandparent, or great great-grandparent, you must be able to establish the direct lineage from you, to your parent, and your parent to your grandparent and so forth. You must upload your certified birth certificate for yourself, your parent, grandparent and so forth to show the direct lineage between you and the original Sealaska shareholder.

Are you adopted?

If you are adopted, you must prove descentancy through your birth parent(s), not your adoptive parent(s). You must provide an original of your certified birth certificate (which lists adoptive parents) AND your Certificate of Live Birth issued prior to adoption (which lists your biological parents).

You cannot own shares in any ANCSA Regional Corporation, except through gifting or inheritance

Before you can apply, you need to answer the following questions above:

Whether you are a US Citizen
 Whether you were eligible to enroll in 1971
 Whether you own shares in another ANCSA regional corporation
 Whether you are enrolled in the Metlakatla Indian Community

Providing false information on the above questions may cause your Class D/L shares to be dissolved and may trigger repayment of any distributions provided.


Enter the name of an original Sealaska shareholder who is a direct, lineal relative (parent, grandparent, great-grandparent, etc.). You will need either their date of birth or the last four digits of their Social Security number.

Enter family tree history (optional).

When you are done, click "Apply."

NOTE: In the next step you will be asked to upload a certified birth certificate showing your relationship to the lineal relative you listed. If it is a grandparent or great-grandparent, you will need to provide your own birth certificate and that of the parent through which you are connected to an original Sealaska shareholder. You will need birth certificates documenting how you are related for each generation removed from the original shareholder.
