**NOTE:** In the next step you will be asked to upload a certified birth certificate showing your relationship to the lineal relative you listed. If it is a grandparent or great-grandparent, you will need to provide your own birth certificate and that of the parent through which you are connected to an original Sealaska shareholder. You will need birth certificates documenting how you are related for each generation removed from the original shareholder.
